Our organization's main focus is youth inclusion and youth participation, and our activities are already making a significant impact on young people in our community. Some of the key activities we're actively conducting include: Youth Leadership Workshops: We are currently hosting workshops where youth members engage in meaningful discussions on leadership styles, decision-making, and conflict resolution. Participants are immersed in practical exercises, role-playing scenarios, and team-building activities, allowing them to apply leadership concepts in real-life situations. Mentorship Programs: Our mentorship programs are thriving, with experienced mentors pairing up with young individuals seeking guidance. Through regular one-on-one meetings, goal-setting sessions, and networking opportunities, we provide a supportive environment that fosters both personal and professional growth. Youth Empowerment Workshops: We are empowering youth through workshops designed to build self-confidence, set goals, and overcome challenges. Motivational speakers and success stories inspire participants, while interactive activities equip them with the tools needed to take control of their lives and contribute positively to their communities. Career Counseling and Job Readiness Programs: Ongoing career counseling sessions include aptitude assessments, guidance on career paths, and assistance with educational and vocational planning. Our job readiness programs offer resume building, interview preparation, and internship opportunities that enhance employability among young people. Youth-led Community Service Projects:
